NOTE: DATE CHANGE CORE: Recordkeeping/Documentation September 9 – 8:30 am – 12:30 pm ~ 4 Credits
Recordkeeping is a must. This course discusses categorizing the difference between illness and injury; what is recordable and what is not, what is recordable as an injury; and, what is recordable as an illness. Recording minor illness/injury will be discussed as well as analyzing the data collected to assist in preventing similar incidents.

CORE: US/Florida DOT Essentials – September 23 – 8:30 am – 12:30 pm ~ 4 Credits
This session is designed to help you understand and comply with rules and regulations that govern motor carriers in the state of Florida. These rules and this training will cover Section 316.302 and Section 316.70 Florida Statutes. In general, Florida Statutes have adopted the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations found in Chapter 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations (49 CFR), Parts 390 through 397, and the Hazardous Materials Transportation Regulations found in 49 CFR, Parts 100 through 180, as they apply to highway transportation.

ELECTIVE: Scaffolding & Fall Protection – September 16– 8:30 am – 12:30 pm ~ 4 Credits
This program is designed to help employees understand how fall prevention works by presenting basic information in this area. Students will learn how good housekeeping skills, specific safety measures & equipment, as well as times maintenance & inspection of equipment are all critical to good fall protection.
