National Poison Prevention Week March 14-20, 2010

- Fact:** Each year, more than 2 million poisonings exposures are reported to the Nation's Poison Centers.
- Fact:** On average, Poison Centers handle one possible poisoning every 13 seconds..
- Fact:** Over 50 percent of poisoning exposures involve children under age 6.
- Fact:** More than 70 percent of all poison deaths occur in adults ages 20 to 59.

Here's how you can keep yourself & your family from accidental poisonings:

- * Lock cleaning and household products in cabinets that are out of a child's reach
- * Choose containers with child-proof packaging
- * Take only medications which were prescribed for you, and only in the prescribed dosage
- * Don't transfer harmful household products out of their original containers
- * Know how to react in poison emergencies
- * Keep emergency numbers close at hand in case of a poisoning accident.
